- Grade 5 and 6 students are required to take one of the three: Band, Chorus, or Orchestra.
- Grade 5 Band has 150 students and Grade 6 Band has 120 students this school year.
- Team teaching is key for success as is lesson groups.
- Music Day-Band, Chorus, and Orchestra students from the high school come and play for and with the grade 5 and 6 students.
- Band O' Roma all the bands go to NHS gym. Students all perform for each other in a round circle. Then all the groups play together. 500 students all together.

- The pilot began in September 2023 with a full implementation expected in fall of 2024.

It was last revised and approved by the Board in June of 2022 so she is not sure why it is being reviewed but she will keep the C & I members updated.
