## Class Descriptions:

(Descriptions have been abbreviated for a general overview)

**Little Fingers in Clay:** (Exiting K-3)

Kids will learn the basics of ceramic hand-building. Campers will experiment with both moist and polymer clays discovering ways to build functional pottery, as well as creative sculpture - monsters, nature-inspired works, zoo creatures, and anything they dream up!

**Clay Workshop:** (Exiting 4-6)

Kids will learn the basics of ceramic hand-building. Campers will experiment with both moist and polymer clays discovering ways to build functional pottery, as well as creative sculpture.

**Dance:** (Exiting K-6)

The basics of Movement and Dance will be the focus of this upbeat and creative camp! Campers will learn the techniques, terminology, and basics of Ballet, Jazz, and Hip Hop. The creative movement part of the program will be with different rhythms, genres, and moods of music to inspire the dancer to move as they interpret and feel. Stretching and strengthening will be a part of each day. Campers will learn a choreographed number to perform on the last day.

**Mixing Musicians:** (Exiting K-6)

Explore written symbols in music, improvisation, story-telling and movement activities through music. Art experiences, including drawing, painting and collaging to create instruments will be incorporated. The combination of art and music will encourage the development of fine motor skills, observation and listening skills, as well as self-expression and sequencing skills.

**Theater Workshop:** (Exiting 3-6) *Only available Slot 1: 8:30am - 10am*

Campers will participate in theater games, improvisation and creative movement exercises in addition to practicing acting and singing. Students in this workshop will not have a final performance, but will learn about and explore different aspects of theater. There is no culminating performance at the end of this two week session.

**Musical Theater Production & Performance Workshop:** (Exiting 4-6)

Slots 2/3 (10 am - 1 pm) *Campers choose only from Slot 1 & is selecting this course for Slot 2/3*

Campers enrolled in this course for two periods will be provided with a more extensive experience than those enrolled in the Theater Workshop. In this workshop students will participate in improvisation, creative movement and theater games, as well as practice acting, singing and dancing. In addition, campers will explore concepts such as character development, stage presence, production design, be asked to audition for their roles and more in preparation for their performance at the end of the two-week session. This is an extensive program which brings together real life components of the musical theater world to camp for students interested in furthering their theatrical understanding.

**Passport to Art:** (Exiting K-6)

Offering your child the chance to travel around the globe without leaving their classroom! This class will give your child a Visa to create crafts typical and unique to different cultures, as they learn about different art forms.

**Wacky Collage Art** (Exiting K-3): *Session 1 Only*

Create art using a variety of materials like yarn, paint, fabric, and more. We will draw real life and imagination. We will practice drawing outside, make mosaics, carve and stamp images and much more!

**Whimsical Watercolors & Acrylics** (Exiting K-3): *Session 1 Only*

This class is for students who would like to explore different art supplies. A variety of subjects and mediums will be explored including watercolor and acrylic. Students will learn to start a painting, how to mix colors, and use techniques such as washes, and underpainting and color theory. Student will have project that use each art material in each step.

**Printmaking** (Exiting 4-6): *Session 1 Only*

Focus on printmaking, including both traditional, and not-so-traditional techniques. Experience intaglio and relief printing via linoleum prints, Styrofoam cutouts, and more! We will use our printing skills to create works of art that stand alone, and that will be used in conjunction with other mediums, so that students can get a glimpse of the diversity and creativity that can be inhabited through printmaking.

**Yoga for Youngsters:** (Exiting K-3)

Yoga allows children to redirect their energy in a positive way by using fun, child-friendly techniques that help them to calm their minds and bodies, especially at times when they may be experiencing nervousness. A fun, lively class with games, nutrition, poses breathing, and chill-axation!

**Jr. Yogi's:** (Exiting 4-6)

Jr. Yogi's is a fun, lively class with games, nutrition, poses breathing, and chill-axation! Sharing, kindness, and self-love come to life through creative breath work, mindful movement, cooperative games, guided meditations, and a cozy relaxation period that travels off the mat.

**Adventures in Mixed Media:** (Exiting K-6)

Enjoy a fun-filled class using a variety of materials including watercolor, oil pastel, papers and found objects. We will experiment with recycled sculptures, printmaking, mosaics, collages and more! Learn the techniques of the many mixed media artists and create your own works of art!

**Liven it up LEGO:** (Exiting K-6)

Get ready for your mission! In this LEGO Education class, you will gain 21st century skills while designing & engineering to make your LEGO pieces come to life. Each day you will participate in a briefing for your daily challenge and be given the chance to explore something new! You will work in small groups to build your own Ferris wheel, "drive your own taxi," set an alarm to catch a monster, and even, trap him!
