Class Descriptions:

Wacky Collage Art (K-3): In this class we will focus on creating using a variety of materials like yarn, paint, fabric, and more. We will draw real life and imagination. We will practice drawing outside, make mosaics, carve, stamp images and much more!

Whimsical Watercolors & Acrylics (K-3): This class is for campers who would like to explore different art supplies. A variety of subjects and mediums will be explored including watercolor and acrylic. Campers will learn to start a painting, how to mix colors, and use techniques such as washes, and underpainting and color theory. Campers will have a project that use each art material in each step.

Printmaking (Gr 4-6): We will have a focused camp of printmaking that will include both traditional and not-so-traditional techniques. Campers will experience intaglio and relief printing via linoleum prints, Styrofoam cutouts, and more! We will use our printing skills to create works of art that stand alone, and that will be used in conjunction with other mediums, so that campers can get a glimpse of the diversity and creativity that can be inhabited through printmaking.

Adventures in Mixed Media: (K-6) Come enjoy a fun filled class using a variety of materials including watercolor, oil pastel, papers and found objects. We will experiment with recycled sculptures, printmaking, mosaics, collages and more! Learn the techniques of the many mixed media artists and create your own works of art!

Passport to Art (4-6): A hands-on program offering campers a chance to travel the world without leaving their work areas! Hands-on activities representing ancient Egypt, Japan, Mexico, Native America, Panama, India, Africa and/or China will be presented. At completion, every participant will have a hand-made "travel book" to remember their "journey's."

Weaving Workshop (K-3): A sequential series of weaving activities that begins with a lesson from a spider and moves from drawing and paper weaving, to yarn weaving on a loom, basket weaving, Ojos de Dios and Weaving in the Round. This is a perfect, hands-on camp.

3D Art Adventures (K-3): Creativity comes alive in three dimensions. A wide variety of sculpture projects, from modeling to additive sculpture in both abstract and realistic expressions will be made using Crayola Model Magic and other art media.

Clay Workshop (K-6) Join us for this clay workshop where campers learn the basics of ceramic hand-building. Campers will experiment with both moist and polymer clays discovering ways to build functional pottery, as well as creative sculpture - monsters, nature-inspired works, zoo creatures, and anything they dream up!

Dance: (K-6) (Session 2 Only): The basics of Movement and Dance will be the focus of this upbeat and creative dance class! Campers will learn the techniques, terminology, and basics of Ballet, Jazz, and Hip Hop. The creative movement part of the program will consist of different rhythms, genres, and moods of music to inspire the dancer to move as they interpret and feel. Campers will learn a choreographed number to perform on the last day.

Theater Workshop (3-6 Only) Only available Slot 1 8:30am - 10am: Campers will participate in theater games, improvisation and creative movement exercises in addition to practicing acting and singing. Campers in this workshop will learn about and explore different aspects of theater. There is no culminating performance at the end of this two week session.

Musical Theater Production & Performance Workshop (3-6) Only available Slots 2/3 10 am - 1 pm: Campers enrolled in this course for two periods will be provided with a more extensive experience than those enrolled in the Theater Workshop. In this workshop students will participate in improvisation, creative movement and theater games, as well as practice acting, singing and dancing. In addition, campers will explore concepts such as character development, stage presence, production design, be asked to audition for their roles and more in preparation for their performance at the end of the two-week session. This is an extensive program which brings together real-life components of the musical theater world to camp for students interested in furthering their theatrical understanding.
