Virtual High School at NHS For Students Frequently Answered Questions!

- VHS is currently open to all students at NHS. VHS offers appropriate courses for grades 9-12 and is an accredited Virtual High School.
- The greatest strength of VHS is the elective courses. *See the course offerings available in the catalogue*.
- Your guidance counselors can help with placement in VHS courses and will typically recommend the courses to you.
- See Mrs. Arnold, the site coordinator, for registration info and enrollment.
- The same NHS policies that determine credits, grades, and withdrawals for face-to-face classes apply for VHS.
- You will not have a scheduled time in your day for VHS. You do the work during free blocks or on your own time at home. *There are deadlines for all VHS coursework and homework.*
- If you are considering taking a VHS course during your senior year to recover credits lost due to failures in classes, please consider very carefully. Historically students in this situation do not fare well in VHS course.
- Only one VHS class may be taken by a student per semester.

Expectations:

- You need to be self-motivated.
- You will have to log into your class at least 5 times a week.
- Check school email for communication with Mrs. Arnold 3 times a week.
- You can expect to work as much for a VHS course as for a face-to-face class, perhaps a bit more as all work is online.
- You will participate in online discussions, presentations, and research with classmates from around the country and sometimes the world.
- You will submit work through drop boxes, blogs, and the online platform of VHS.
- Before you begin you will sign a contract regarding behavior and academic expectations.
- There are daily/weekly deadlines for all VHS work that is submitted.

- Mrs. Arnold will communicate with VHS teachers as necessary.
