



SMART FAQ's

1. **Where do we drop off/pick up?**

TO DROP OFF YOUR CHILD

Parking is in the front of the building and you **MUST** walk your child in through the doors to the right of the main entrance. **Do not park in the bus lanes.**

Please check your child in each day in the CAFETORIUM

Their nametag will be out on the sign-in table for them.

TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD you must come inside to the Cafetorium, sign the "sign out" sheet and exit through the same side entrance.

2. **What if someone else is coming for my child?**

If your child is NOT going home with you, you need to provide a note stating who is coming for your child.

3. **Can I drop my child off at the curb?**

No, You MUST come inside to drop off/pick up your child.

4. **Will there be a security guard on site?**

Yes. We will have security guards on site during program hours.

5. **Is there "play" time?**

While every moment at SMART is "play", we do provide some playground time so that we can run some energy off.

6. **Is there a snack or lunch break?**

There is **ALWAYS** time for snack usually at the start of the 2nd and 3rd periods of the day. **NO NUT PRODUCTS** or foods manufactured in facilities where nuts are processed.

7. **What should my child wear to SMART?**

Appropriate warm weather clothing should be worn. Keep in mind that many of the classes are messy. Please send a smock labeled with your child's name. For safety reasons, please refrain from sending your child in flip flops.

8. **How does my child get from one class to the next?**

We employ student interns (high school students) who take the children from class to class and escort them to the bathroom. No one goes unescorted.

9. **Who is that person with the camera?**

Newspaper reporters may occasionally visit the school to photograph children and publish articles dealing with the program activities. Any parent who does not wish to have his/her child photographed or interviewed by local newspapers should indicate that preference in writing to the Program Site Coordinator or the Director of Summer Programs

10. **What happens on the last day?**

On the last day of each program we have a "showcase" so that you can see what the children have been doing. We cut our regular day short so that there is time for parents/caregivers to enjoy both a display of all the artwork in various classes, as well as a short presentation from the performance classes in the cafetorium.

11. **What should we do if our child will miss part of SMART due other commitments?**

Please inform the Program's Site Supervisor if your child will be absent from SMART due to travel. Especially if he/she will miss the last day as this requires an early pack-up of all of their art work.
